VI. ATTENDANCE POLICY - Every participant in the Huntsville Leadership Institute is required to attend all sessions. THE ORIENTATION AND TWO-DAY OVERNIGHT RETREAT IS MANDATORY. The program is designed so that each subject adds to a well-rounded foundation for any future leadership roles. During each session, the entire class day is part of the HLI experience. Once the session begins, you are expected to remain with the class. Breaks, meals and transportation as a group are important to the process of the program and are considered part of the session. Program participants may not miss the orientation, retreat session, nor accrue more than 10 combined hours of missed absences from program hours. Participants that accrue more than 10 hours of absence may appeal to the HLI Board to continue program participation; all requests will be considered, but such absences could result in removal from the program with no refund of tuition. If a participant has accrued more than 8 hours of absences, his/her employer will be notified. A 15 minute late arrival may result in a 1-hour absence deduction.
